GREAT TEXAS PUBLIC SPACE DESIGNEE - 2017

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places and a designated Main Street City, Georgetown Town Square is anchored by the 1911 Williamson County Courthouse. Using recent infrastructure and rehabilitation projects, Town Square has been the focal point of community events and economic activity. The Red Poppy Festival, Lighting of the Square, and the Christmas Stroll are a few of the most well known Town Square events.

Downtown Master Plans have been in the works since 2001 and most recently updated in 2014. The Tax Reinvestment Zone helped to fund the municipality's many projects within the historic zone. Festivals have never been easier or more enjoyable since the mobility enhancements, streetscape arts, expanded sidewalks, and outdoor dining areas have been strengthened. Visit the new City Hall and Georgetown Art Center located in the 1895 Fire Station to feel the history of Georgetown come to life in 2017.
