PLANNING SCHOLARSHIP – APA TEXAS: MIDWEST SECTION

The scholarship is provided to promote planning within the Midwest Section of the Texas APA Chapter by providing partial funding to students enrolled in a university located within the Midwest Section. It is anticipated that one (1) \$1,000 student scholarship will be awarded in December 2023 and later recognized at the Holiday Party Event on December 15, 2023.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible students include graduate and undergraduate students enrolled in a university located in the Midwest Section during the 2023 calendar year and who intend to pursue careers as practicing planners (majors in Planning, Public Administration, Geography, Public Health, etc.).

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Application requirements include:

- 1. Completed application with student's signature;
- 2. Maximum of two-page personal and background statement written by the student, describing how their graduate education will be applied to career goals, why they chose planning as a career path, and any financial need (numbers and details not necessary);
- 3. Maximum of two (2) letters of recommendation in support of the student and career goals;
- 4. Transcripts of undergraduate course work and/or current graduate course work; and
- 5. Résumé (optional if the information is supplied in the personal statement).

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection will be determined by the board of the Midwest Section of the APA Texas Chapter, based on the following criteria:

- Commitment to planning as reflected in personal statement and resume;
- Academic achievement;
- Letters of recommendation;
- Financial need; and
- Intention to attend the Holiday Party Event once it is scheduled.

DEADLINE: December 1, 2023

The applications need to be <u>received by 5:00 p.m. on December 1, 2023</u>. NO late applications will be accepted.
